AN ALL-DAY
LENTEN WORKSHOP

On **Friday, March 12**, St. Andrew's By-the-Sea Episcopal Church, 307 Harbor Blvd. (US Hwy 98 E) in Destin, will host an **all-day workshop** presented by **Fr. William A. Meninger** OCSO, a Trappist monk of St. Benedict's Monastery in Snowmass, Colorado. The topic of the workshop will be "**An Introduction to the Enneagram.**"

Fr. Meninger is one of the leading figures in the Centering Prayer Movement – a movement dedicated to bringing the power of prayer to the very heart of daily experience. He was ordained in the Diocese of Yakima, Washington. He entered St. Joseph's Abbey in Spencer, Massachusetts, in 1963. For 15 years he served as retreat master and Scripture professor. Fr. Meninger regularly conducts workshops and retreats around the country. We are fortunate that he will be in the Destin area for a week in March.

Fr. Meninger is the author of *The Loving Search for God: Contemplative Prayer and the Prayer of Unknowing* and *The Process of Forgiveness* in addition to many articles and tapes.

The Enneagram is an ancient spiritual guidance tool that can be used to help us discern what is preventing us from a full and true relationship with God. The Enneagram is a study of nine basic types of people: it explains why we behave the way we do and points to specific directions for individual growth. This is a delightful and enjoyable workshop and Fr. Meninger is an excellent guide.
